

One of the benefits of joining Preschool Promise is the tuition assistance available to reduce the cost of sending your 4-year-old to a Star Rated program. Costs vary for each Preschool site – some are even free, such as Dayton Public Schools and Miami Valley Child Development Centers (MVCDC) – if you meet certain eligibility requirements.

The great news about Preschool Promise is tuition assistance is available to ALL families no matter your income. Tuition Assistance also covers co-pays for families on Publicly Funded Child Care (Title XX).

How to read the tuition assistance table

To estimate your tuition assistance, first identify the row that reflects your family’s size and income level. Then look at the appropriate Family Income Tier chart on the right to see the estimated monthly tuition assistance you may be eligible to receive.

- 3. If your child attends an in-home family child care provider your tuition assistance will follow a different table.** Please fill out an application or call (937) 723-2741 between 9 a.m.-4 p.m. and ask to speak with a Preschool Promise specialist to discuss your tuition assistance.
- 4. Families who live in Dayton or the Dayton Public School District** who choose to enroll their child in a Star Rated program elsewhere in Montgomery County are eligible for tuition assistance if the program agrees to become part of the Preschool Promise.
